



2023 MSGA Spring A-Team Qualifying

The first NGC Spring A-Team match is scheduled for
Saturday, April 15th

A-Team Qualifying to be held March 1st – April 10th

- Rounds may be played any time
- A maximum of 4 qualifying rounds can be played by each player
- The lowest two round total (number of strokes over par) will be used to determine eligibility
- The lowest single round will take a spot on the team
- The next best two additional players will be on the team
- No entry fee

Format

- Play from the blue tees and hole out every putt.
- Lift, clean, and place in your own fairway, one club-length, no closer to the hole. Additionally, lift, clean, rake and place in all bunkers taking as much relief as necessary to place your ball on a playable bit of sand, no closer to the hole.
- Player must check in with the Pro Shop and declare their round as a qualifying round prior to start.
- Play with a witness who signs your scorecard (gross score only)
 - Witness must be a MGA member
 - Turn your card into the Pro Shop following the round
- Mark your card with any hole/layout adjustments for course conditions and/or maintenance.
 - i.e. Played #5 from front tee as par 4, Did not play #7 (closed)

Notes

- If spots are still vacant the A-Team Captains may use the following to fill any vacant spots:
 - Play in MGA tournaments during 2022
 - Play in tournaments outside the club (posted publicly and verified)
 - Play in prior A-Team matches
